- 2) To what is Jude referring when he speaks of the “heavenly messengers going outside their rightful domain”?

- 3) In verse 6 Jude reminds the readers that the heavenly messengers rebelled and abandoned their appointed realms. What do you think this means? (Gen. 6: 1-4)
- 4) In what ways have you personally seen “dreamers” corrupt and pollute the Body of Christ (the Church)?
- 5) In what ways have I corrupted or polluted the Body of Christ (the Church)?

How does this verse challenge you? Does it reveal an attribute of God's character?
