- 1) In verse 16 Jude talks about those who are constantly complaining and finding fault with everyone. In what ways have you “listened” to these people? How can you be an agent of Truth and Peace in these situations?

- 2) In verse 17, how does Jude address the believers? How does he encourage them to remain faithful?

3) To whom does Jude refer when reminding them to be faithful?

4) What “prophecies” were they reminded of? How do they endure?

5) What does Jude say is evidence of their true belief?

6) How do you pray “honest” prayers led by the Spirit?

7) What does it mean to you to “pray in the Spirit”?

How does this verse challenge you? Does it reveal an attribute of God's character?
