3) Has there ever been a time when your “foolish ways” have caused others to stumble or other followers to face disgrace?

4) How do you respond to those who don’t understand your commitment to God and serving Him? How is it different if it comes from family?

How does this verse challenge you? Does it reveal an attribute of God's character?
