



Chasing The Word: The Red Letters

Luke 2:42-52

⁴⁹ Jesus asked, “Why did you have to look for me? You should have known that I must be where my Father’s work is!”

Pray: As I begin to read Your Word, O God, I pray the prayer of Samuel – “Speak Lord, for your servant is listening.” I invite you to open my mind, my heart and my ears, that I might know you deeper.

Respond: Read the verse again. This time, ask the Holy Spirit if there is an invitation in this word or phrase for you today. Write it here.

Rest: Read the verse one last time. Now hold the word or phrase as you rest.
Thank God for this gift today.

Resolve: As an action step – carry this gift with you into the rest of your day. Use
